Your responsibilities

The Airworthiness Inspector is responsible to the Senior Airworthiness Inspector (SAI) and his primary responsibilities are to assist the SAI for all certification, operational inspection and continued surveillance covering all aspects of aircraft airworthiness to ensure safety compliance. In particular;

- To attend correspondence covering all aspects of Airworthiness.
- To maintain and update the information/records related to airworthiness in respect of aircraft.
- To maintain and update Minimum Equipment List in co-ordination with Senior Airworthiness Inspector (SAI).
- To create, maintain and update databases for audits (initial/annual) and production of audit reports pertaining to Approved Maintenance Organisation in co-ordination with SAI.
- Perform any other related duties as directed by the Director of Aeronautical Licensing and CAI.

Your qualifications

- Holds or has held an Aircraft Maintenance License (Airframe and Power plant or Avionics).
- or A post-secondary diploma/degree in aircraft maintenance or an acceptable combination of education, training and experience related to aircraft maintenance and/or manufacturing.
- A minimum of 4 years' experience in aircraft maintenance, and preferably in quality assurance.
- Holding Aircraft Certifying Authority (ACA) or Shop Certifying Authority (SCA) in an approved aircraft maintenance organization (AMO)
